

# CHILD MENTAL HEALTH CARE REFORMS IN ARMENIA

### ***How will the project affect these people?***

The direct beneficiaries-1 Will have a wider range of available services and possibility for more thorough multisided assistance.

The direct.beneficiaries-2 will benefit from this project in sense of their effectiveness. Due to the partnership implied by the agreement planned in this project, the cooperation between services and the possibility for the service providers to redirect their users upon necessity and thus provide a wider range of services which will be helpful both for the service providers and their users.
